

Visitors/Contractors Data Protection & Confidentiality Agreement

At Victory, we place great importance on the privacy of our customers and the security of their data.

Victory complies with the Data Protection Act 1998 and has a Data Protection Policy in place. A copy of this policy is available on request. All staff are trained in Data Protection awareness and we all have a duty to comply with the law and protect customers' privacy.

We have implemented security policies, rules and technical measures to protect the personal data that we have under our control from unauthorised access, improper use or disclosure, unauthorised modification, unlawful destruction or accidental loss. We have formal data sharing frameworks and confidentiality agreements in order to fulfil contract obligations.

Whilst visiting a Victory office or place of work, you may become aware of personal and sensitive data about residents or service users. Visitors and contractors are obliged to uphold the privacy of our customers at all times, both during a visit and after this has been completed.
